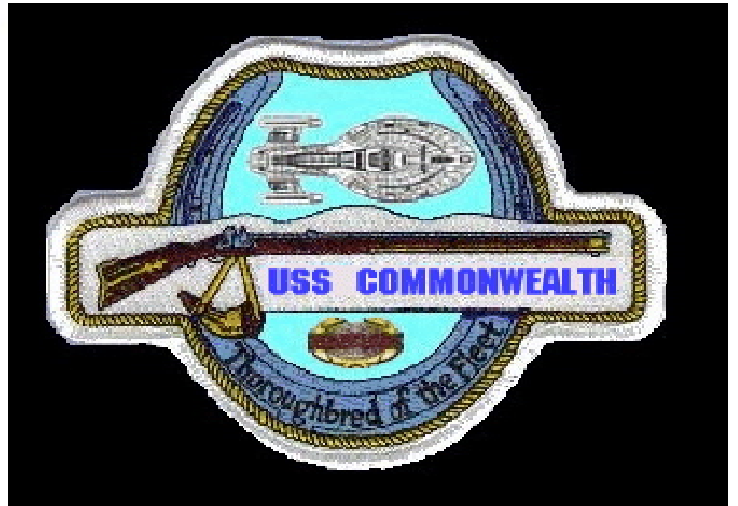


# HAILING FREQUENCIES
